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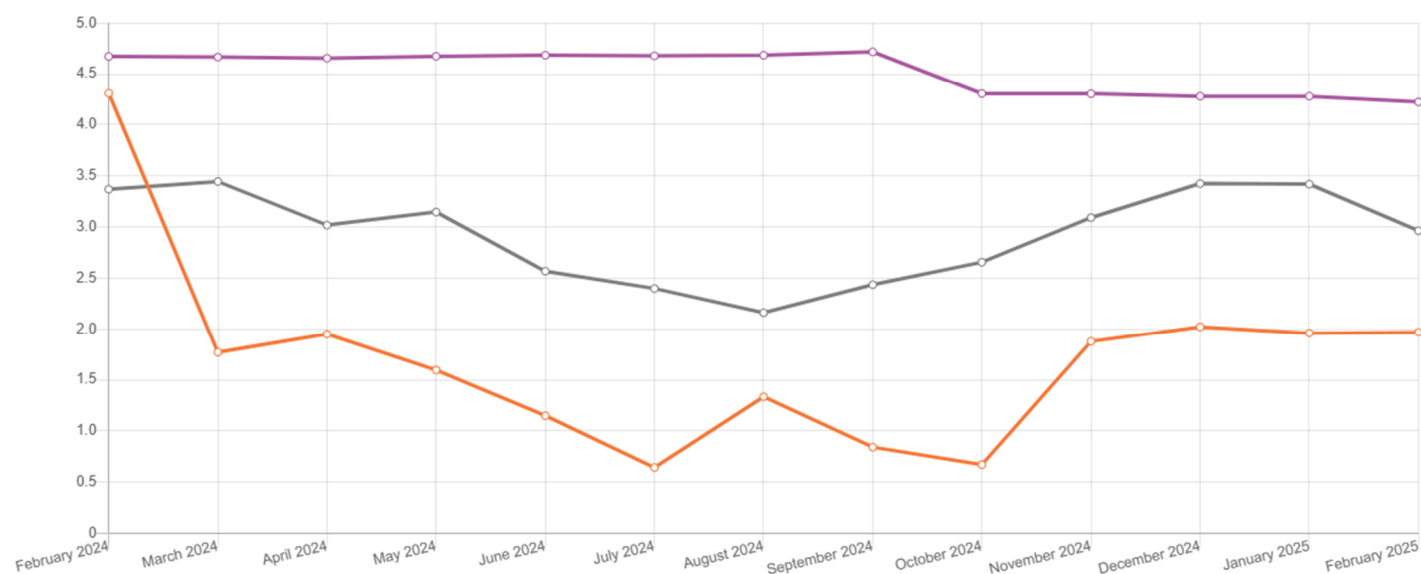
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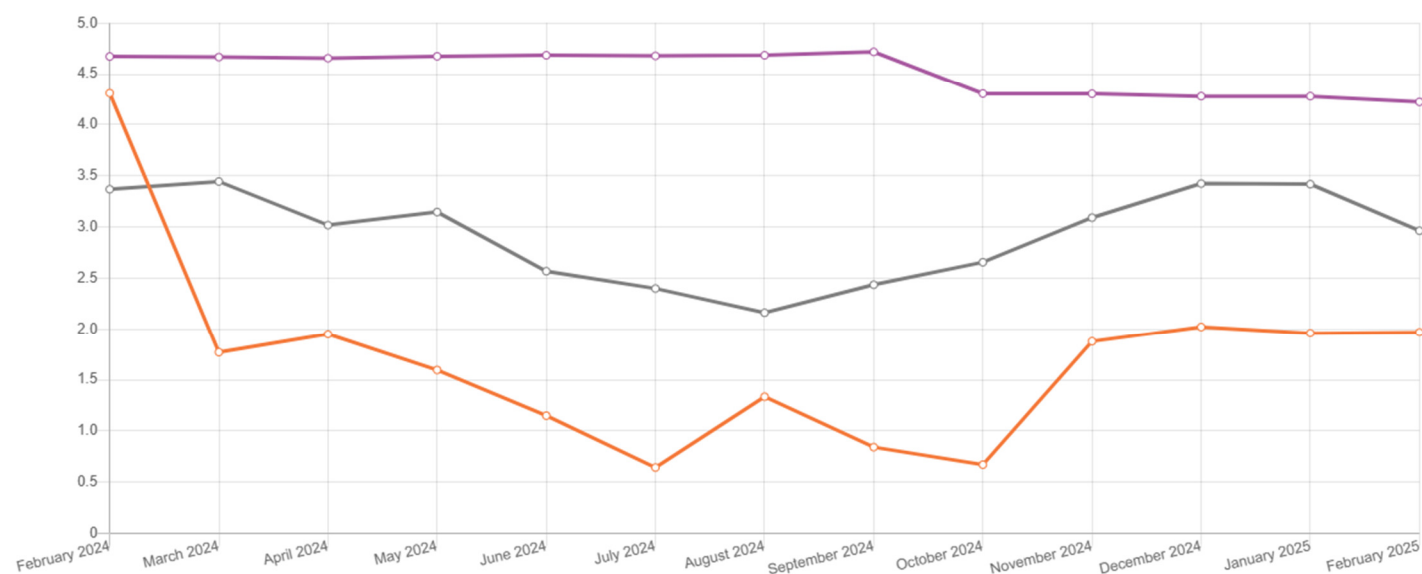
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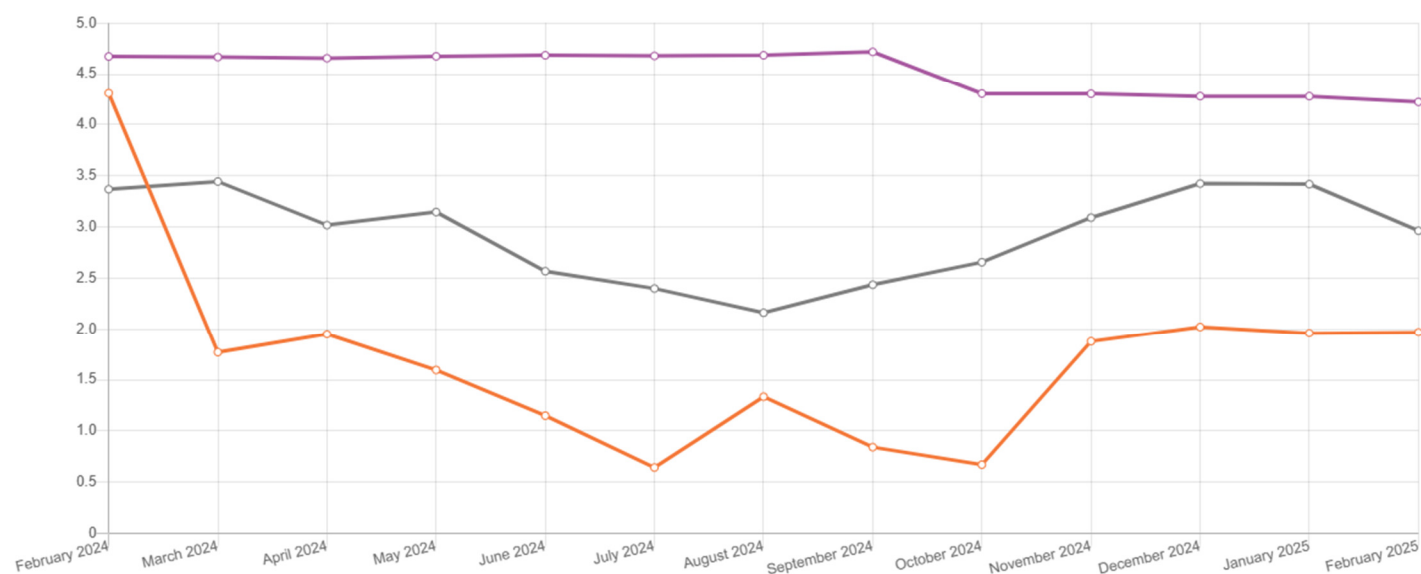
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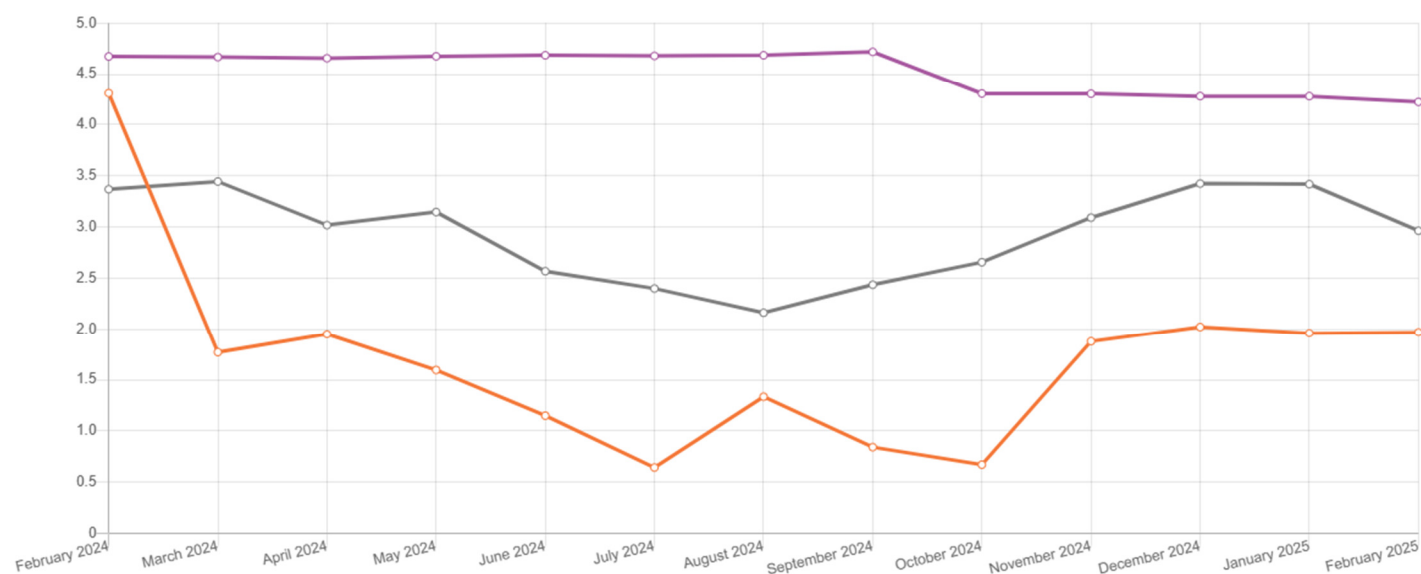
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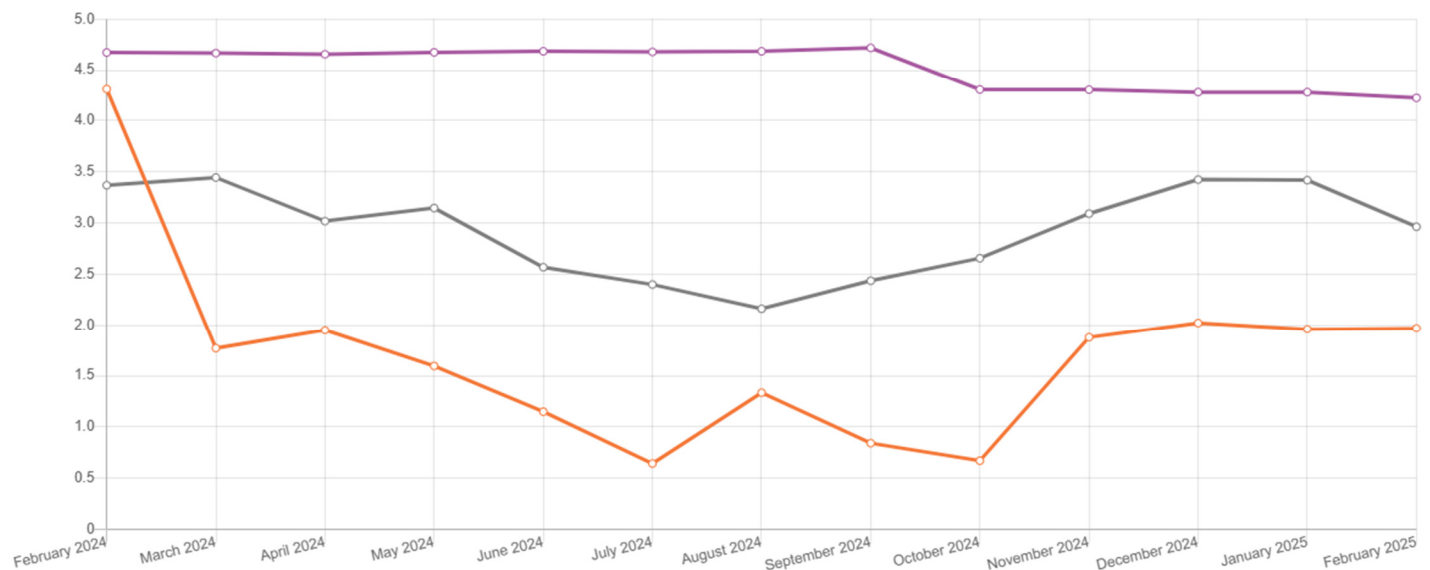
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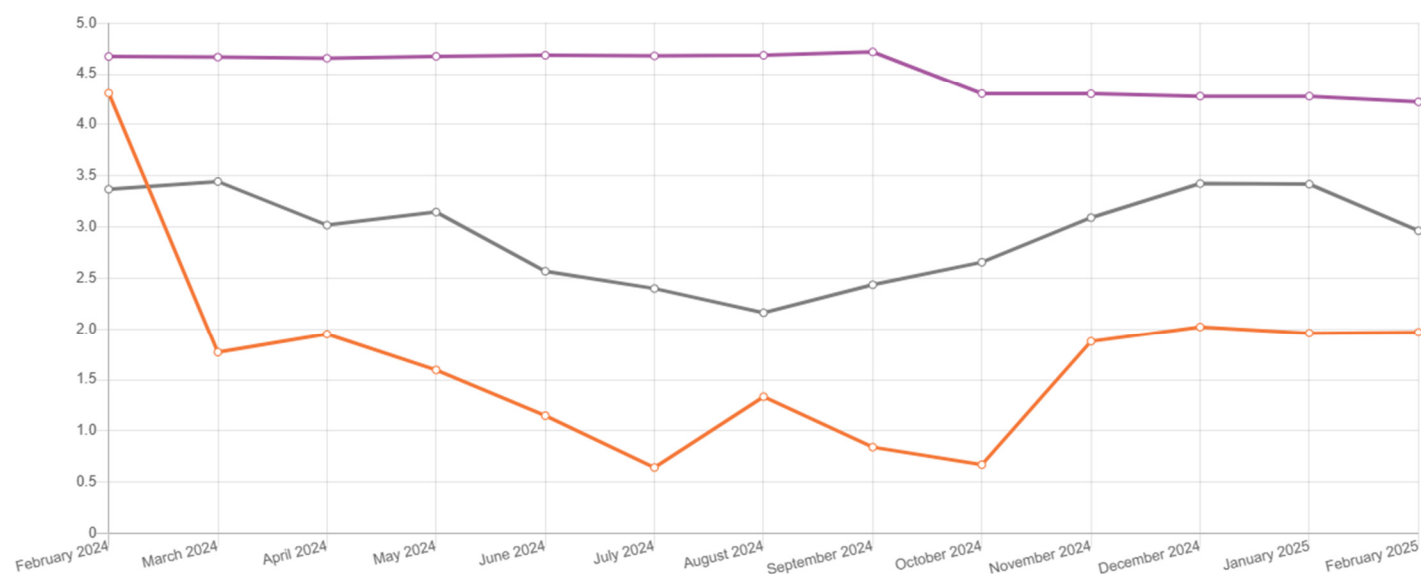
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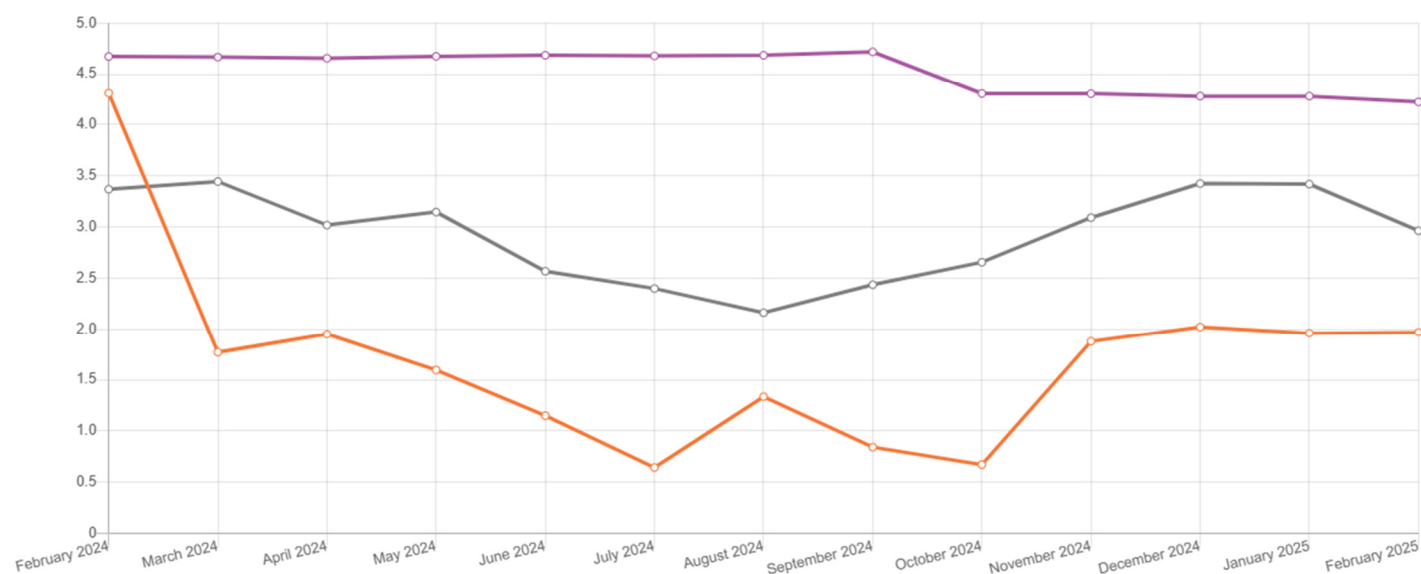
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AUTOMATED METER READING (AMR)

We continue to experience ERT failures on some meters – which typically show up in the cold, winter months. The battery on the ERT itself is what typically fails after about eight (8) years.

Please be aware that Meota staff will be in the area addressing failed ERTs along with our annual meter change out program beginning immediately and through out the year.

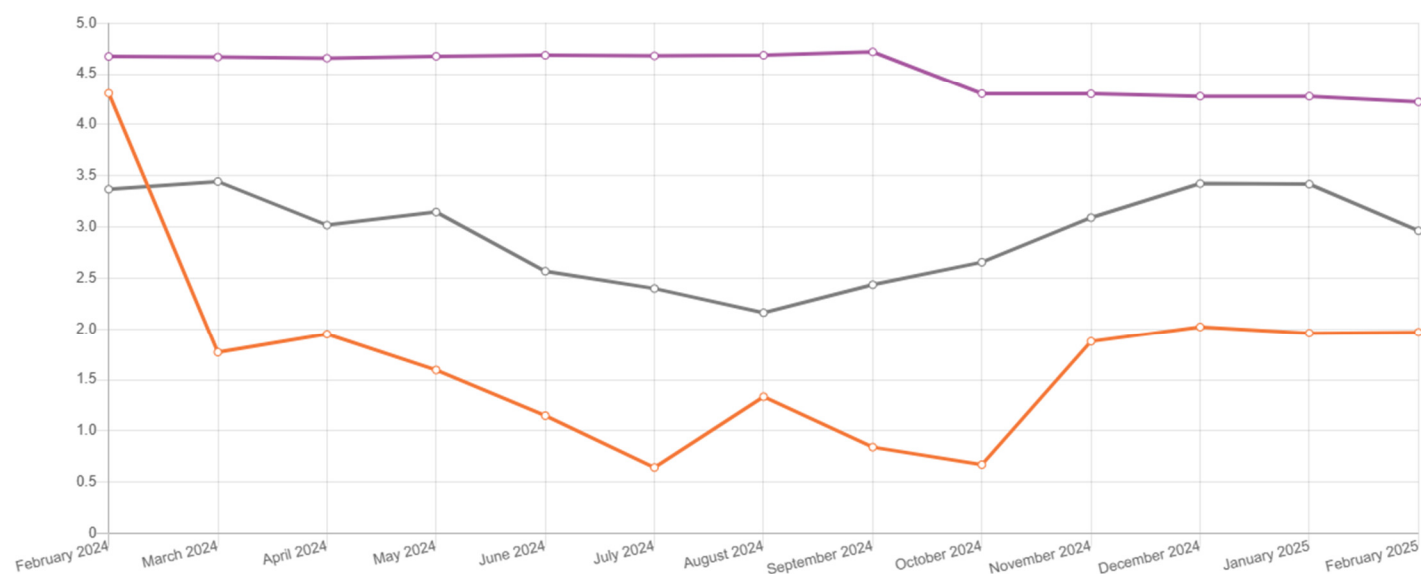
